

BOARD MEMBER AUTHORITY

A member is elected to a Board. A Board has power only when in session at a legally called meeting.

Thus, when a Board is not in session, an individual member has no particular authority.

In other instances, an individual Board member, including the chairman, has power when the Board, by vote, has delegated specific authority to him or her.
