

STUDENT HEALTH SERVICES

The Board may appoint a school nurse to function in the school health program. A school nurse shall be a registered professional nurse licensed in New Hampshire.

The Board may employ or contract with a licensed practical nurse or a certified nursing assistant, to work under the direct supervision of the registered nurse. Treatment by an LPN or CAN is limited to first aid care. The RN will notify parents before a student is permitted to go home.

1. Any student not in class because of illness or injury must report to the nurse before re-entry.
2. All student medications must be kept in the custody of the school nurse. No prescription medication is to be administered by school personnel except as prescribed by a doctor and accompanied by a parental permission form.
3. All accidents occurring on school property are to be reported to the school nurse or administrative designee. When necessary, the school principal should be informed as soon as possible. Students attending school during the extended day, night, or summer school or any other time when the school nurse is not in the building are to report to the main office or to the attending staff person in case of illness or injury.
